



## **CE-Marking**

### **Application to Connectors, Outlets, Patch Panels, Patch Cords and Distributors**

#### **1. Preface**

The CE-Mark is a mark of conformity for national inspecting authorities, which indicates for a product the compliance with corresponding EC-Directives. It is neither a quality nor a safety mark.

For Telegärtner products the EC-Directives “Low Voltage Directive (2006/95/EC)” and “EMC Directive (2004/108/EC)” come into consideration.

#### **2. Low Voltage Directive**

The guidelines of the Low Voltage Directive (issue August 2007) state among others installation material and cords have to be CE-marked. Telegärtner therefore brands all outlets, patch panels, patch cords and distributors with the CE-Mark.

#### **3. EMC Directive**

The guidelines of the EMC Directive (issue 21. May 2007) excludes:

- Cables, cables sets and cable accessories
- Connectors and outlets

These products must not be CE-marked.

#### **4. Consequences to Telegärtner products**

All Telegärtner products marked with the CE-Mark applies to the Low Voltage Directive.

Products for use in shielded data applications are tested to EMC requirements to ensure product and system safety for our customers. For corresponding advices please look into our product documents.
