1. RoHS-Directive 2011/65/EU recast

Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council of 08.06.2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The following substances are involved:

Lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)

Limits without exemptions:

1000 ppm: Lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE

100 ppm: Cadmium

2. Declaration of Conformity

We herewith declare that all our products are RoHS-compliant. Exemptions listed in the annex of the RoHS-Directive may be used. The marking of the RoHS-compliance is printed on our delivery notes, invoices and labels of the product packing with "RoHS-compliant".

3. RoHS ban of substances and certification

The directive specifies the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances. In the annex exemptions are described. The lawgiver does not require certificates, declarations, no test reports or marks. This principle is called "presumption of conformity" and devotes the prevention of unneeded bureaucracy.
